We are delighted to announce the **Construction & Property Charity 5's football challenge 2010** at the Goals Soccer Centre, Wimbledon. As in previous years, the main competition sponsor is Hays Construction, but we are delighted to welcome Construction News as the new media partner for the event.

The competition is open to teams from any organisation involved in the construction industry. The eighth in an annual series, this year's tournament kicks off at mid-day on **Sunday, 16th May 2010**.

Situated just off the A3, the Goals Centre is within easy reach of London and the M25 orbital (see Goals website www.goalsfootball.co.uk).

The competition format is designed to give everybody a great day's football with men's and (if we can get at least 4 teams) ladies' competitions. With leagues followed by cup and plate knock outs, all teams will get at least 5 games and a minimum of one hour's football, with considerably more for teams that go through to the final stages.

Companies can enter as many teams as they like. Each team comprises of a maximum of 8 players, of which 5 can play at any one time. Teams are drawn into groups of 4-6 depending on overall numbers. The top two teams will go through to the cup and the rest into the plate competition.

The entry fee is £395 + vat, which covers all pitches, referees, bottled water, snack bars and lunch for all players, plus a substantial donation to the Lighthouse Club - the charity for the Construction Industry. There is a sports bar, and supporters will be very welcome.

We enclose a general information sheet plus an entry form. If you would like to enter your company team, simply fill in the form and fax back or, better still, post back with your entry cheque.
