We are delighted to announce the launch of the Property Cup competition 2010, staged once again in association with Estates Gazette and sponsored by Hays Property & Surveying.

As ever the competition gives the top Property teams the chance to pit skills against each other in a World Cup style competition, with group matches followed by knockout cup stages. The games through to the semi finals are all played at Gunnersbury Park, with the finals at the Millwall New Den ground. The winning semi finalists play in the cup final, preceded by the plate final for the two losing semi finalists.

The 2009 competition was highly successful, although played with less teams than usual due to the economic downturn which seriously hit trading for the commercial property sector. We are hoping that we will see a recovery in team numbers this year as the property market improves and are aiming to stage a traditional 16 team competition.

We regularly contribute a charity donation to The Lighthouse Club from Construction and Property football events averaging in excess of £10,000 per year.

We do hope that you will be able to join us for the 2010 competition which kicks off on Wednesday 31st March at 5.30pm.

The cost of entry remains at £1075 for the third year running. This ensures all teams get at least three games in the qualifying stages, with the option of playing six matches for those that qualify through to the semi final stages. For those four teams there is of course the opportunity to play at the excellent New Den stadium, and to see the coverage in Estates Gazette afterwards, but everyone taking part enjoys this long established competition, now in its 44th year!
